A School for Children, Inc. operates solely from the resources collected from tuition, tax-deductible donations, and parent fundraisings. Public schools receive funds from the state, federal and local tax funds to operate. Private schools must operate solely from tuition, donations and funds from parent fundraising activities. Computer Maintenance	\$40.00	All students in grades 8-9 must have their own wireless-ready laptop computer. This fee covers the cost of ink and paper for printing. We encourage all students to purchase a Portable Flash Drive with a necklace for carrying.

Required Academic Performance Sessions (R.A.P.S.) is required of those students who do not perform up to **their** full potential. **These are not tutorials**; they cost \$75.00 *per session*. (*For further explanation see the Parent/ Student Handbook.*)

Additional Curriculum Fees:

1. The on-line bookstore proved to be somewhat costly for ASC families. Therefore, in an effort to help parents save, the school will purchase all books and provide all copies (**\$425.00 book usage & copy fees**). Lost or damaged books and copy pages will be charged directly to parents and must be replaced immediately. No child will be able to matriculate without proper academic materials.
2. **Materials Fee of \$50.00** is assessed per child per year.
3. Field Trips are a very important part of our curriculum. Parents will be expected to pay for all field trips. ASC does not have adequate staff when a child does not attend a scheduled field trip. Therefore, all students must participate in field trips.

School Lunch Program:

A School for Children does not have enough students to participate in the free & reduced lunch programs as administered by the State Board of Education, however, from time-to-time parents do provide lunch for our students.

Also, during the 2009-2010 there may be opportunity to provide a rotating list and scheduled of restaurant purchased lunches. A menu choice list and schedule will be provided to you at least two-weeks before the start of school.

Also, be advised that a full refrigerator and microwaves are available for students' use. Please be advised that students **MAY NOT** consume soft drinks or any drinks with excessive sugars and/or carbonation during the school day.
